(1872-1904)

1899	Commissioned in the Royal Army Medical Corps
1899	Selected for service with the Egyptian Army
1902	Accompanied Colonel Sparkes into the Bahr al-Ghazal and helped to recover the body of Scott-Barbour
1902	Undertook sanitary work in Alexandria during a cholera outbreak; later returned to the Sudan as Inspector in the Bahr al-Ghazal
1904	Took part in the Nyam Nyam (Azande) patrol, Bahr al-Ghazal
1904	Died of wounds at Tonj
